INTERNSHIP PROGRAM INFORMATION

The Airmid Theatre Company offers internships as part of our annual summer festival on Long Island, NY. The internship program is designed to provide students and recent graduates with an opportunity to expand current their as part of a professional team in a small professional theatre company.

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age to qualify, and must be motivated individuals with a strong respect for the collaborative nature of theatre.

Internship Positions Available: Internship opportunities are available in most areas of the company.

Eligibility: A candidate must be a graduate student; an undergraduate student; or have graduated from college within 12 months of beginning the internship. Minimum GPA 3.0

General Information: Interns are expected to work between 20 and 40 hours a week during an 8 to 12 week internship period. Internships are primarily offered during the summer, however fall, and winter/spring semesters can be considered for administrative internships. Interns may receive academic credit if an agreement is made between the Airmid and the intern's college or university.

Application Procedures: Candidates must complete an application form and submit it with their cover letter and resume. Some internship positions require additional application items, such as a design or writing samples. All application items must be submitted as a complete package. Incomplete applications will not be reviewed.

Application Deadlines: April 15, 2011. Late applications will not be considered.
