On January 14<sup>th</sup>, 2011 from 6-8pm, join EunJung Park and The Huntington Arts Council at the Main Street Petite Gallery for "*With Love With Art*", a solo exhibition. The exhibit will run from January 14<sup>th</sup> – February 28<sup>th</sup>, 2011.

EunJung Park supplies her audience with paintings and glass vials filled with colored liquids while plastic tubes are placed in front of images. She often refers to her youth when she was ill and spent an extended period of time within a hospital. Her approach is both conceptual and figurative. This exhibit is unlike any other and truly personal.
