

The Cultural Impact of NYSCA on Long Island



The New York State Council of the Arts provides critical support for many different cultural organizations across the Long Island region. Funded organizations include museums, art centers, theatres, music presenters, film programs, and an award winning radio station.

Each year NYSCA provides approximately \$1 million dollars in direct grants to larger arts organization on Long Island, and Decentralization Re-grant funds are distributed around the region by local arts councils to support a variety of public arts programs. NYSCA also provides valuable professional guidance, training, and networking opportunities such as the state-wide Cultural Blueprints initiative.
