2019 HONOREES

NANCY RICHNER

Nancy Richner is the Director of the Hofstra University Museum of Art. Prior to her current role, she held positions at several art museums including Education Director at the Hofstra University Museum, Program Manager at the Nassau County Museum of Art, and Assistant Director of Education at the Museum of Modern Art. Nancy's career has focused on advancing the transformational role of the visual arts, particularly from the standpoint of their ability to develop visual literacy skills, engage people in civic dialogue, and create partnerships among individuals and groups. She is passionate about helping all people engage in the powerful experiences that authentic works of art and objects can have in stimulating learners' curiosity, reflection, and understanding about our world.

Nancy earned her master's degree in Museum Education from the George Washington University and an undergraduate degree from Northwestern University. She is a member of ArtTable, the American Alliance of Museums, EdCom, the Museum Education Roundtable, and the National Art Education Association and is active in various professional organizations. She has been published in *Museum News*, *Journal of Aesthetic Education* and the *Journal of Museum Education*, and was recognized as Museum Educator of the Year for the northeast region by the National Art Educators' Association.

MARIA LORETA CELITAN

Maria Loreta Celitan, founder of Sol Y Sombra dance company, holds degrees in Art and Art History, an M.A. in Comparative Religions and an advanced Certificate in Gerontology. In addition to her extensive study in a variety of dance related fields (Classical Ballet, Modern Dance, Near Eastern and Bharatanatyam), the field of Spanish dance led her to study in Spain with several outstanding professionals such as Paco Romero, Carmen Cortex, La Tati and more. Maria holds certifications in advanced Hatha and Cardiac Yoga, Creative Movement for Children, and Dance Therapy from the Turtle Bay Music School in Manhattan.

Maria's appearances and solo concerts are numerous and span many years. As a company member she danced with the likes of Estrella Morna's Ballet de Madrid and The American Spanish Dance Theatre, appearing at the U.N., Lincoln Center's Out-of-Doors, and Washington D.C.'s

Armory Arts Center. Maria has taught Spanish/Latin dance for a variety of schools and institutions throughout the New York metropolitan area.

Until recently Maria was on the faculty of SUNY, Stony Brook University Center for Dance, Movement, and Somatic Learning. She is an arts-in-education exponent working for several well-known arts-in-education programs. Maria dedicates her time to participate on panels and serve as a member of boards for various organizations.

MAXINE JUROW

Maxine Jurow, an intuitive painter, holds a Bachelor of Fine Arts and a Masters Degree in Painting and Education, both from Long Island University's CW Post Campus. Her professional life has included teaching art followed by twenty years as the Executive Director of Literacy Suffolk.

Working primarily with acrylic paint on a variety of surfaces, canvas, wood panel, and mylar, Maxine's work is yielding unique results and a different tactile experience. She has been inspired by travel to Australia, the Caribbean, Morocco, the Southwest, and her home of Long Island. Memories of these places are the inspiration for her abstract landscapes and are, in a sense, a meditation that she continually returns to.

Maxine was recognized by Long Island Pulse Magazine with inclusion in the 2009 Annual Artist VIP List. She has shown extensively in the tri-state area with numerous solo exhibitions and group shows.
