All media and approaches are welcome. Storytelling, realism, escapism, traditional, video, sculpture, spoken word: the options are endless.

Juror Liz Fusco is an award winning artist who lives on Long Island. She earned her BFA and MA at Long Island University. Because of her love of plants, flowers and natural subjects, she continued on to earn her certificate of Botanical Illustration at the New York Botanical Gardens in the Bronx, New York. Liz paints in watercolor and oil, with flowers, landscapes and still life being her favorite subjects. She has exhibited her work nationally, receiving the Roth Award for Botanical Distinction for her painting of "Tiger Lilies" at Filoli Gardens, in San Francisco in 2017.

ENTRIES

- Entries must be original to entrant. Framed entries require hanging wire.
- Selected works are chosen by the juror. No more than two works per artist are selected.

ELIGIBILITY

- All artists and media.

SIZE

- Hanging works should not exceed 48 inches in any direction.
- Standing work should not exceed 72 inches in any direction.
- Video/audio work cannot exceed 50MB in file size.

ENTRY FEE

- **First three entries**

 Full-time students \$25
 Artist Circle members \$30
 Non-members \$40
 Additional entries \$5 each
- Please note: **Fees are nonrefundable.**

LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

- Works are insured while in the possession of the Huntington Arts Council.
