Entries are not limited to traditional media; spoken word, exploring the body through dance or video etc. are all encouraged.

Juror Christophe Lima is an Artist and Educator who creates profound and thought provoking paintings and drawings. Everything she does is with the aim of connecting to, and opening up, meaningful conversations with others. She was born in Queens, NY in 1983 and moved to Long Island in 2014.

EXPLORATION OF THE HUMAN FORM: NOVEMBER 22 - DECEMBER 23, 2022

ENTRIES

- Entries must be original to entrant. Framed entries require hanging wire.
- Selected works are chosen by the juror. No more than two works per artist are selected.

ELIGIBILITY

- All artists and media.

SIZE

- Hanging works should not exceed 48 inches in any direction.
- Standing work should not exceed 72 inches in any direction.
- Video/audio work cannot exceed 50MB in file size.

ENTRY FEE

• First three entries

- JOURNEY* school students \$15
- Full-time students \$25
- Artist Circle members \$30
- Non-members \$40
- Additional entries \$5 each

Please note: **Fees are nonrefundable.**

LIABILITY AND INSURANCE

- Works are insured while in the possession of the Huntington Arts Council.

SALES

- HAC retains a 25% commission on sold work.
